Constitution Hill Flats Redevelopment Programme – Work is beginning on the redevelopment of the flat complex at Constitution Hill. The Irish Times (01 Feb 2021) reported that Constitution Hill will be the only retrofit scheme in the first tranche where the 90 apartments will be upgraded and new homes built, resulting in 131 apartments on the site. We wish all our parishioners in Constitution every blessing at this time of upheaval and change and pray that the work will be carried out swiftly and well for the good of all the residents.



Sacramental Preparation Programmes – In November we begin working with the children who are preparing to receive Sacraments in 2022.
