This year the candles feature the image of the 'Pieta' from the Harry Clarke window in the church. A powerful image of Mary holding the body of her son, Jesus. We pray in a special way for all who are mourning the loss of a loved one at this time and we remember the words of Jesus – 'Blessed are those who mourn; they will be comforted'.

#### Family Mass
