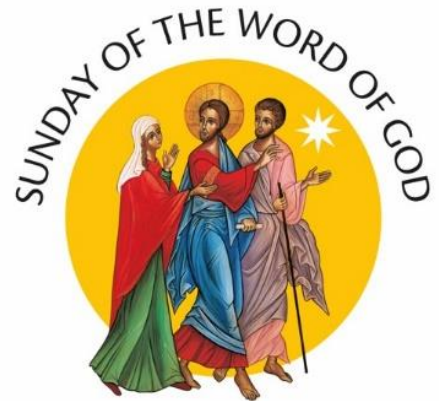
Catholic Schools Week 2022



This Sunday begins Catholic Schools Week 2022. This year's theme is 'Catholic Schools: Living life to the full'.
