We have experienced a 53% drop in donations since the beginning of COVID and the envelopes are our main source of income. Thank you for your continued support.

North Anne Street Entrance – Work will begin on repairing and painting one of the entrances from North Anne Street. The work should take about a week and this entrance will remain closed for that time. Please pay attention to any health & safety signage in the church.

Christmas Crib – John Behan has finished building the crib structure and this week Dublin based artist Vauney Strahan will create a beautiful 'Bethlehem scene' on the back wall of the crib. We will then put the figures back in, close up the crib and put the statues back in the recess. Thank you to all who have been involved in this work.
